

## Sell Your Chametz by Monday Morning, March 29, 2010

It is customary to sell your Chametz, any product with leavening, which cannot be disposed of before Pesach. These products remain in your own home, sequestered from other foods and locked up to prevent access, but are technically in the possession of a non-Jew for the duration of the holiday. Rabbi Booth serves as your agent to affect the sale. It is necessary only that you sign your name to a document appointing him as your agent return it to the office by Monday morning, March 29 at 8:00 a.m. An email specifically designating Rabbi Booth as your agent to sell Chametz is also acceptable. You may also return this form by facsimile (650-948-2712), but it must be received by the designated deadline. If this form is mailed, please assure arrival by Monday morning, March 29.

It is also a wonderful custom at this time to give a gift of Tzedakah, called ma-ot chittin, to assure that the needs of the poor are met for Pesach. Mazon and Second Harvest are excellent charities to fulfill this mitzvah.

### DELEGATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR SALE OF CHAMETZ

KNOW YE that I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi David Booth to act in my place and stead, and in my behalf to sell all Chametz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by the Torah and Rabbinic Law (e.g., Chametz, doubt of Chametz, and all kinds of Chametz mixtures), as well as Chametz that tends to harden and to adhere to a surface inside of pans, pots, and cooking and usable utensils, and all kinds of live animals that have been eating Chametz or mixtures thereof, and to lease all places wherein the Chametz owned by me may be found, especially in the premises indicated below and elsewhere.

Rabbi David Booth has the full right to sell and to lease by transactions, as he deems fit and proper and for such time which he believes necessary in accordance with all terms detailed in the general authorization contract, which is in the possession of Rabbi Booth, authorizing him to sell Chametz on behalf of others. Said general authorization contract is incorporated herein and made a part of this agreement.

I hereby give Rabbi Booth full power and authority to appoint a substitute in his stead, with full power to sell and lease as provided herein. The above granted power is in conformity with all Torah, Rabbinical laws and regulations, and also in accordance with the laws of the State of California and of the United States.
